The 12^{th} annual Alyeska Climbathon took place on Saturday, September 14^{th} , 2019. 324 climbers hit the mountain and with great weather and determination, a total of 1,163 laps were made in ten hours! An impressive \$92 thousand dollars was raised. 100% of funds stay in the state of Alaska with 25% going to the Girdwood Health Clinic and 75% to Let Every Woman Know-Alaska to further our mission of gynecologic cancer awareness and support for Alaskan women and families faced with a GYN cancer diagnosis.
