The Retreat Setting

Yukon Island is a haven in wondrous Kachemak Bay, south of Anchorage, Alaska, on the tip of the Kenai Peninsula. It is the largest island in Kachemak Bay, seven miles across the water from small town Homer. The island, a significant archaeological site, has dense woods, heavy vegetation, tidal zones, abundant sea life and wildlife such as salmon, otters, and bald eagles.

The Center

The Dream House was built in 1994 and is over 3000 square feet, and includes a meeting room, library, kitchen, bedrooms, dormitory, and sunny dining room. Enjoy bathing in a wood-fired sauna (no plumbing) and using rustic, modern outhouses. Heat is from central wood stoves, cooking and auxiliary heating from propane. The alternative energy system provides modest power and lighting.
