2016 Alyeska Climbathon RECAP

The 2016 Alyeska Climbathon took place on Saturday, September 10th. 290 climbers hit the mountain and with great weather and determination, a total of 1200 laps were made in ten hours! An impressive \$48 thousand dollars was raised. 100% of funds stay in the state of Alaska with 25% going to the Girdwood Clinic and 75% to Let Every Woman Know-Alaska to further our mission of gynecologic cancer awareness and support for Alaskan women and families faced with a GYN cancer diagnosis. The Alyeska Climbathon is an official part of the international Globeathon to End Women's Cancer during GYN cancer awareness month: September.
