The 11th annual Alyeska Climbathon took place on Saturday, September 8th, 2018. 303 climbers hit the mountain and with great weather and determination, a total of 1,172 laps were made in ten hours! An impressive \$76 thousand dollars was raised. 100% of funds stay in the state of Alaska with 25% going to the Girdwood Health Clinic and 75% to Let Every Woman Know-Alaska to further our mission of gynecologic cancer awareness and support for Alaskan women and families faced with a GYN cancer diagnosis.


Let's Talk About It: Ongoing Gynecologic Cancer Support Group
